How to Use the NALS Library

1. The Librarian is Janet F. Vineyard, 151 Plantz Road, Johnstown, N.Y. 12095.
2. Please order by number, author and title.
3. You may borrow up to four books and up to six pamphlets at a time. You may list second choices in the event some of your first choices are not available.
4. With your request send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope so the Librarian can advise you which books were sent to you and when, which books are in waiting, the postage due and the insurance costs if necessary.
5. The loan period is one month. The librarian will specify the date the material must be placed in the post office on its way back to the Library. The charge for overdue books is 5 cents per day per book.
6. You will be responsible for postage both ways. See the Librarian's notice to you for the amount. Use the U.S. Postal Service "Library Rate" which is very inexpensive.
7. Because of their value some books must be insured from and to the NALS Library. If the books are insured when you receive them, please insure them when you return them. See the Librarian's notice to you for the cost.
8. You will be expected to pay the cost of replacing any book that is lost or damaged. If the material cannot be replaced then you will be expected to pay the cost incurred in locating and copying it.
9. Books will be sent to you well wrapped. Please return them wrapped as well.
10. Please notify the Librarian by postcard when you return the borrowed material. This will help her locate the material if it does not arrive within a reasonable time.
