Welcome to the seed exchange! The seed exchange is made possible through the generosity of everyone who has taken the time to pollinate, tag, protect, harvest, candle and sometimes even package the results of their labor of love. Other donors have gone to the effort of collecting native species seed growing in the wild. Without the efforts of the donors, the seed exchange would not be possible.

Thank you Larry for doing such a great job with the seed exchange instructions. I will use Larry's instructions as much as possible but please pay close attention to ALL of the information as there maybe changes. Needless delays can be avoided if the instructions are followed.

1. The point of contact for Canadian donors for 2006 was Dolores Nelson. I know that I am not just speaking for myself when I say "Thank You, Dolores".
2. As many of you know the United States Agricultural Department and the Animal Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) started a new program called "Small Lots of Seed Program" for importing seed from outside of the US this year. This eliminated the purchase of a Phytosanitary certificate and made it easier on Dolores in Canada. I believe that this program will work well once it is fine tuned.
3. This list will be mailed by conventional mail to members who requested a paper copy. Copies will be mailed to Donors first, then to overseas members, then to Canadian and U.S. members. The goal is to try to have the list arrive with donors first then all other members at the same time. The list will be published on the NALS website in early March. NALS members who signed up for electronic distribution/notification will receive an email notice of posting which will be timed to coincide with mailed delivery dates. Orders from non-NALS members will not be accepted before April 1, 2007. This list expires June 1, 2007 and will be removed from the NALS website at that time. Please see that your order is received before this deadline.
4. We will continue to accept Visa and Master Card as a form of payment. **Take time to ensure your card information is correct and legible.** PayPal will be accepted again this year. Please read the ordering procedures section below!
5. I am again offering bonus seed to all donors. One (1) free packet will be given for every seed number you have listed, with a limit of three (3) packets. If you are a donor, please deduct these bonus seeds from your cost at the indicated place on the order blank.

6. **Pictures!** With the assistance of the NALS Webmaster and select donors, we have posted some pictures of the parents of the seeds on the NALS web site. Look for a designation in the last column of the seed list where "Y" indicates there will be a photo(s) available. Photos will be on the web site with the list and will be available by clicking on the appropriate position on the line you are reading (no more hunting for the image!).

A few donors have included pictures on packets that they have sent to the exchange. I have indicated where this is so.

7. **Descriptions!** I have tried to include as much of a description as the donor has provided. The better the description, the more likely someone will find a reason to purchase the seed. I assume most of you have access to copies of the RHS International Lily Register; lily books, etc. such that you can look up a description of named lilies. If you do not have the International Lily Register, you can purchase it from the RHS or access the new web site created by Gerry Danen at [www.lilyregister.com](http://www.lilyregister.com) and click on Lily Register. To read more about this new site, read the article by Gerry in the NALS Fall 2006 Quarterly Bulletin pp. 30-32

8. Whenever you see a donor remember to thank them for the effort they have put into making the Seed Exchange possible. If the donor took the extra time and effort to submit photos thank them for that additional effort as well! It is the fervent desire of many of the donors that those of you who purchase some of their seed continue their work. Please consider doing so. If you have success with someone's material, let him or her hear about it. Everyone likes hearing about his or her offspring!!

A special "Thank You" to John and Joan Svenson and Ieuan Evans for the incredible number of seed contributed to the Exchange this year.

Many donors have taken the time and effort to collect species seed from native stands. If you are fortunate enough to obtain some of this seed please do your part to assure their continued purity and survival.

9. **Some Disclaimers.** Every effort has been made to inspect seed and to ensure that the seed you purchase has visible embryos. It is physically impossible for the Seed Chair to candle or re-candle every seed that has been donated. Where seed is very small, dark, or where embryos are hard to distinguish I have tried to give some indication of this fact. If you wish clearly visible embryos do not order from these lots. In some cases extra seed has been given to compensate for these conditions and is so noted.

You may experience reduced germination from some tetraploid crosses. You may also note that tetraploids do not grow as rapidly as diploids do. I have not attempted to compensate for these deficiencies by including extra seed as there is more intrinsic value in tetra seed and the reward from tetras is in the size and form of the resulting plant.

You may experience significantly reduced germination from interdivisional offerings. Ed Soboczenski suggests that you try germinating your OTs in water. (The actual process is a 20 min soak in 20% diluted Clorox (itself 5% bleach) then soaking in water which is frequently changed and diligently monitored until small plants form and which are transplanted to small flats under lights). I use this method myself on the unusual crosses. Ed learned of this method from Harrison Peters. However, if you have a method that works for you stick with it.

### **Seed Listings**

Seeds are listed by Division and identified by seed number, donor, description, number of seed packets available, and number of seeds in each packet. If there is no listing for the number of seeds, then the packet contains 25 seeds, or maybe a few more. There are two alternate designations for the number of seeds. For example, if the number is given as: 3 @21, this should be interpreted as three packets each containing 21 seeds. Another designation used is: 8 +18s, this should be interpreted as there are 8 packets of 25 and one additional packet (the last one to be given out) that only contains 18 seeds. Finally, you may see a designation that looks like: 25+ or 30 +, this should be interpreted as your dauntless seed chair just gave up after packing 25/30 packs of 25 seeds and there at least a few more packs than the quoted number (and which could be packed if that many were to be sold)!

The seed numbers are interpreted in this way. The first digit identifies the Lily Division or category; the second digit gives

the year of the sale (7 for 2007). The other digits identify the seed lot itself. This code establishes a unique number for each lot for ten years.

**Seed Ordering Procedures (Includes Changes from Last Year - Please Read!)**

Please read this section carefully. By following the instructions and suggestions given below you will have the best chance of getting the seeds you want in the shortest possible time. Please follow the directions given in the “Auction” section if you wish to bid on auction items.

1. **Order by mail or email only** (no phone orders, no fax orders).

2. **Conventional Mail Orders:** Use the order form attached. Order by catalog # only and list your 2nd and 3rd choices (please do not repeat any numbers from the first column as you 2nd or 3rd choices). Be reasonable in your expectations about your chances on small and desirable lots; if you are not a donor, desirable lots containing only a few packets typically sell out within the first 20 or 30 orders (mostly from donors who order early). Prepare your order well. There will be no refunds on cash, checks, PayPal or money orders. If you pay by credit card, you may request that your order be reduced to whatever I can supply and I will recalculate your charge for packets and shipping. A small receipt will be included for charge orders to show the billed amount. **Keep a record of your order, as order blanks will not be returned.**

3. **Electronic Ordering:** This is a new feature this year. You have several options:

- You may scan your paper copy of the filled in order blank and email it to me.
- You may download the form from the website, fill it out and email it to me.
- You may use the shopping cart feature on the website to order seeds. If you use this feature be aware that the web site is not monitoring inventory. Even though a packet is placed in your cart it may not be available. Please list acceptable alternates in the comments box or be willing to accept whatever I substitute. The Webmaster and I will attempt to update the list daily as to availability.

- Your order will be filled in the order received (including mailed in orders) and held pending payment. Seeds will be shipped when I receive payment. Payment can be made by conventional mail for: checks, bank drafts or credit card information. Customers are encouraged to use PayPal, as I will ship as soon as I receive notification. I understand that you can now use PayPal, without establishing a detailed account with them simply by supplying your name and credit card information. This is done over a secure connection. See the website for details.

4. **Send payment in U.S. currency payable to NALS.**

- Visa and Master Card (only!) are accepted. PayPal accepted for the first time this year. See NALS website.
- U.S. members use personal checks, money orders, credit card, or PayPal.
- Canadian members use personal checks (Please mark your check “U.S. Funds”, do not calculate monetary exchange rate), Money Orders in U.S. funds, credit card, or PayPal.
- All other members make payments in U.S. funds using bank drafts payable through a U.S. bank, International Money Order, credit card, or PayPal.

5. **Pricing.** Most seed is priced at \$1.00 per packet (unless otherwise noted) plus these additional postage and supply charges:

1- 20 packets: U.S. \$1.50	21 - 40 packets: U.S. \$2.50
40 - 50 packets: U.S. \$3.00	50 + packets: U.S. \$4.00

Please calculate these charges based on the number of packets ordered not the number of seed numbers ordered.

6. **Limitations.** The following limitations are intended to make desirable seeds available to as many members as possible. The filling of seed orders is still on a first-come-first-serve basis, but the chance is better that the seed you desire will still be here when your order arrives. However, when there are only a few packets of seed, the earlier your order arrives the better your chances.

a. The limit on packets for any individual seed number is:

- b. The limit for this year's seed is 30 **Seed Numbers**. There is no limit on last year's seed.  
 c. There is a **special limitation of one packet each on Dr. Griesbach's Tetraploid Trumpets and OT's** ( Seed Numbers: 67-217, 67-218, 67-219, 87-185, and 87-187.)

7. Some members may want more seeds than the above limitations allow. I will accommodate those members with the following procedure. For orders of this year's seed that exceed 30 seed numbers, I will fill your order up to the first 30 seed numbers and then suspend your order until March 30, 2007 before completing it. The initial fill will be held until after March 30, 2007 unless you include postage for two separate mailings. Please be sure to include alternate choices if you wish to use this option.

Abbreviations These abbreviations are used in the list: OP = open pollinated, HP = hand pollinated (Note: I have assumed that most hybridizers use some means to ensure that their intended cross is protected from previous or unintended pollinations. All of these crosses could be labeled as protected pollination. I have just omitted this designation unless I have been made aware otherwise by the donor), sdg./sdlg = seedling, IE = immediate epigeal, DE = delayed epigeal, IH = immediate hypogeal, DH = delayed hypogeal, w/ = with, OT, O/T = an Oriental/ Trumpet hybrid. Most others are basic.

Free Seed NALS will donate leftover seed to regional lily societies world wide for the purpose of furthering the genus *Lilium*. Please write on your organizations letterhead stating the purpose, quantity and type of material desired. Requests will be processed after the sale is closed.

You may experience significantly reduced germination from interdivisional offerings. Ed Soboczenski suggests that you try germinating your OTs in water. (The actual process is a 20 min soak in 20% diluted Clorox (itself 5% bleach) then soaking in water which is frequently changed and diligently monitored until small plants form and which are transplanted to small flats under lights). I use this method myself on the unusual crosses. Ed learned of this method from Harrison Peters. However, if you have a method that works for you stick with it.

#### Division VIII, Interdivisional Hybrids

You may experience significantly reduced germination from interdivisional offerings. Ed Soboczenski suggests that you try germinating your OTs in water. (The actual process is a 20 min soak in 20% diluted Clorox (itself 5% bleach) then soaking in water which is frequently changed and diligently monitored until small plants form and which are transplanted to small flats under lights). I use this method myself on the unusual crosses. Ed learned of this method from Harrison Peters. However, if you have a method that works for you stick with it.

'01210 Yellow' (Richards) -- seedling from cross 'White Henry' x *L. rubellum* obtained from the New Zealand Lily Society Seed List

'94 -- 4402' (Diehl) -- [( Tetra L. regale x Tetra White Henryi) x Leslie Woodriff] Dorothy Schaeffer OT hybrid, white with yellow throat, tall, vigorous, fertile

'81-265-02' (Diehl) -- [Evans 81-265 x (Griesbach Tetra trumpet x Tetra orange flare from tetra Black Beauty)], white tetra OT with gold center and pink highlights

'Northern Carillon x mixed OT/T pollen' (Jim Ault) -- Seed parent with large, full white flowers with a dramatic red throat, great fragrance; pollen a mix from 12 different 4N trumpets and Orienpets, pollen collected in Bob Griesbach's garden, a mix of wonderful shapes, colors, habits, etc., mostly tricolors or selections with dramatic red interiors, including fertile sister 89-15. Should yield valuable breeding stock.

'Roy's Select ' (Brian Bergman) -- the Earl N. Hornback Award Winner at the 2006 NALS Lily Show, best stem of an unnamed hybrid seedling grown from seed by exhibitor. This lily has great potential in the seedlings, tremendous disease resistance, dark green foliage and larger flowers, taller plants. Roy's Select, redheart seedling, itself tends to be fertile with a lot of OT pollen. Originally known as R-S-1.

'T99 - 66, 69 99A' (Diehl) -- Warren Summers hybrid shown at NALS 2006 show. Large flowers pale yellow

'Tet OT. Sdlg Luminary type' (Bowen) -- [(Tetra White Henryi x (Tetra Regale x Tetra White Henryi)) x (Tetra Black Beauty x Tetra White Henryi, F2)]. According to Vicki, the original Tetra White Henryi was a gift from Dr. Griesbach. She crossed it with pollen from Griesbach sdlg. (Tet. Regale x Tet. White Henryi). (Tetra Black Beauty x Tetra White Henryi F2) pollen came from Harrison Peters. Pete described it as much like Leslie Woodriff, not as good, but very fertile. This pod parent is a very strong and fertile seedling that resembles the Luminary Strain.

'TT - 1' (Schaeffer) -- Tetra 'White Henryi' x tetra white seedling

### Division IX. Species

Germination characteristics as noted in lily books have been given for the species. Frequently, this only partially tells the story and you are encouraged to read about the habits of the species before planting your seeds. Most IE types are straightforward. Some HD types respond best when there naturally occurring conditions are duplicated. For example, the Western American species germinate in the fall in cool conditions and winter over with a first leaf appearing in the spring. If you sow this seed outdoors in the spring you will likely experience a total crop failure. Anyone interested in the species should consider joining the Species Lily Preservation Group (SLPG).

#### Description and notes of species

\*All specie seed from HUNTPA, Paul Hunter, is hand pollinated except for the *L. michiganense* seed.

*L. amabile* (Crook) -- very light orange - it is possible that the very light (VL) orange flowering *L. amabile* stems are from a cross *L. amabile* v. *lutem* and *L. amabile* v. *unicolor* from a time before I kept records. The (L) light orange *L. amabile* could be from *L. amabile* v. *lutem* and *L. amabile* (dark (red) orange) also from before I kept records. However I have no recollection of ever making these type of crosses. I make these comments because of the light orange variations and as well the very light orange coloured variation has a much reduce spotting pattern.

*L. amabile* v. *lutem* (Crook) -- The cross that produced the *L. amabile* v. *lutem* seed is from a long time grown *L. amabile* v. *lutem* in my gardens x *L. amabile* v. *lutem* from the SLPG. My old *L. amabile* v. *lutem* is 1c, fully recurved with very dark brown to near black spotting. The SLPG v. *lutem* is 1bc, partially recurved with reddish brown spotting.

*L. bolanderi*, (Francom) -- from dark red to peachy-yellow pod and pollen parents, all w spots inside. Height 4-5', Del Norte Co, California

*L. columbianum* (Francom) -- nodding, glowing yellow Turk's-cap flowers with purple-red spots. From the redwood forests of th Northern California coast, elevation 1600', height 150-180cm, 5-6'

*L. columbianum/kelloggii* (Francom) -- *L. columbianum* integrated with *L. kelloggii* in the wild. Dainty yellow to white looms with maroon spots. Lighter blooms darken to wine with age. Height 120-180cm, 4-6'

*L. dauricum* (Crook) -- pink overlay sdls, F1 cross - These pink overlay *L. dauricum* seedlings came from a cross of an *L. dauricum* (red overlay) from the SLPG x a long time grown *L. dauricum* in my gardens which has no overlay. There are 5 pink overlay seedlings each one having a pink overlay to varying degrees, the pink overlay also fades over various time frames, from one day to four days. I made the crosses from one seedling to the next cross until a full circle had been completed.

*L. kelloggii* (Francom) -- Dainty white to ink Turk's cap with yellow midrib, small spots. Flowers darken to wine with age. Height 5-6', wonderfully fragrant!

*L. maritimum* (Francom) -- Dainty orange flowers with maroon spots. Height 4-6', elevation 400'. Grow with dappled shade in light, humusy-rich, well drained soil.

*L. rubescens* (Francom) -- White up-facing trumpet with small maroon spots. Flowers darken to wine with age. Height 5-6', extremely fragrant!

*L. papilliferum* x sib (Jim Ault) -- Rare species that looks like a dainty *L. pumilum* with 1-3 strongly revolute, nodding

flowers produced over grassy foliage on 12" tall stems; flowers sweetly fragrant, pomegranate red with darker fine lines and spots, some papillae. Beautiful!

*L. sulphureum* x sib (Jim Ault) -- Plants 4' tall, one flower each, flowers very long and narrow with abruptly flared and strongly rolled tips, quite long (to 10"). Petals white with some light yellow in the throat and either yellow green or green striping on the outside. Copious stem bulbs. Container grown, hardiness unknown

*L. superbum* (Francom) -- Yellow to orange with maroon spots. From Coolspring Township, Mercer Co., PA. Seeds collected by Joseph Nemmer

*L. shastense* (Francom) -- Also: *Lilium pardalinum ssp shastense*. Looks like a small *Lilium pardalinum* except has yellow, rarely red pollen. Height 4-5'

*L. sargentiae* x sib (Jim Ault) -- Plants 4-5' tall, flowers two per stem, large, basal half of each flower narrow, then flaring with rolled tips, petals white with brownish violet stripes on the outside and light yellow throats. Copious stem bulbils. Container grown, hardiness unknown.

*L. taliense var. kaichen* X sib (Jim Ault) -- Plants tall (to 4.5 feet), slender, with up to 5 flowers each on long arching pedicels, flowers 1c, strongly revolute, creamy white with yellow blush, dark green nectary and many fine violet spots.

*L. washingtonianum ssp purpuranscens* (Francom) -- White trumpet with small maroon spots. Darkens to wine with age. Few to many spots. Height 5-6', fragrant!

*L. washingtonianum ssp washingtonianum* (Francom) -- White trumpet with few to many small maroon spots. Extremely fragrant! Plumas Co., California
